
Vagas and ACNUR: How to register your resume on the recruitment platform

The recruitment company Vagas and the UN Agency for Refugees (UNHCR) have prepared this practical guide for refugees and migrants to provide guidance on how to register your resume on the Vagas.com.br platform. Thus, increasing the chances of being hired in the formal Brazilian job market.

Changing the language on the platform

It is possible to change the navigation language of the Vagas.com.br platform to English and Spanish. To do so, simply click on the flag representing the desired language (located in the lower right corner of the <u>page</u>). IMPORTANT: Even if you choose to change the language on the website, it is important to fill in the information in Portuguese so that your CV appears in companies' searches for vacancies in Brazil.



Step 1: Register your resume on <u>Vagas.com.br</u>


1. In the upper right corner of the main page, click on "Register for free".




2. Fill in the pre-registration data (e-mail, CPF and country), and if you are a migrant or refugee click on "I am a refugee" and create a password.







3. By selecting the "I am refugee" option, you can enter your current situation in Brazil




4. Four options will appear: I am a recognized refugee, I am applying for refugee status, I have a residence for the purpose of humanitarian reception, I am a





Venezuelan national with temporary residence or Other. You can then choose the type of document you wish to provide.

Don't forget to read and accept the Terms of Use. After that, click on "Start using now!"



5. Before proceeding with the registration, you will need to verify your e-mail. Go to your inbox, open the "Confirmation e-mail" message and click the "Confirm e-mail" (*Confirmar e-mail*) button







6. We are almost there! To finish the registration, just fill in your personal data, such as name, date of birth, and cell phone (optional).



7. By clicking on "Finish Register", you will be redirected to the resume, with the data previously filled in. Now, just complete the other fields in the items: "Personal Data", "Objectives", "Professional Resume", "Academic and Complementary training", "Languages", "Professional history" and "Additional Information".



Step 2: How to make your resume ready to search for job openings

If your resume is incomplete, check on the fill-in bar which fields are pending. Note that the red buttons (in the picture below) represent the mandatory fields. By clicking each one, you will be directed to the respective field to add the information.



Remember: for each update you make, click the "Save" button. After filling in the basic and required information, you will see the following message:

This means that you can start your search for job openings now!

Step 3: How to download your resume

If you need a printed or PDF resume at the time of a job interview, you can also use the information registered on Vagas.






- **1.** To do this, simply access <u>Vagas.com.br</u> using your username/login and password.
- 2. On your services page, click on "Update Resume".

3. Click on the "Download resume" option on the right side of the screen:






Your resume will be downloaded in PDF format, without identification from Vagas, to be used as you wish.

Step 4: How to search for job openings and apply

1. On the main page of <u>Vagas.com.br</u> there is a search bar where you can search for job opportunities by job title, area, location, or company. After entering what you are looking for, click the click the "Search" button:



2. Jobs related to the search terms will be displayed. Note that you can sort the search according to relevance or publication date, and also use the filters (available on the left side of the screen)):



3. Found an interesting job opening? Click on it and then on the "Apply" button:



4. If you are not logged in, access your registration using your username/login and password. Then, wait for the application confirmation page.





5. If the company requests tests, fill out the required forms and click "Confirm Application":




Data always up-to-date

To contact the candidates, the company responsible for the selection process uses the phone number or e-mail registered in the resume and application history. Therefore, it is essential to keep the **data updated and check your e-mail whenever possible.**

More information and tips

If you already have a CV registered on the platform, you can also fill in your status as a refugee. Simply log in to the platform, click on your profile photo, enter your country of nationality under Personal Data, click on "I am a refugee" and choose from the options for your current situation in Brazil.
