

UNHCR University Fee Grants for Refugees in Bulgaria 2024



Higher education is a key goal for sustainable development, as highlighted in the 2030 Agenda and Sustainable Development Goal 4. Despite this, only 7% of refugees were enrolled in higher education globally in 2023, compared to a global enrolment rate of 38%. UNHCR aims to change this with the 15by30 target, striving to have 15% of refugees in higher education by 2030.

UNHCR Bulgaria is providing university fee grants to refugee students in Bulgaria. Through these grants, UNHCR will reimburse the enrolment fees of refugee university students attending state and private universities.



Grant Amount:

3,000 BGN per student for the academic year (two semesters)



Eligibility Criteria:

- Have been granted international or temporary protection in Bulgaria
- Be under 35 years old at the start of studies
- Admitted to or enrolled in a Bulgarian university
- Not receiving another scholarship



Required Documents:

- Refugee status or temporary protection card
- Acceptance or enrolment document from a Bulgarian university
- Declaration of no other scholarship
- Short motivation letter
- CV



Application Process:
