HEALTH INFORMATION

FOR REFUGEES & INTERNALLY DISPLACED PERSONS (IDPS)

Health services in Kurdistan Region of Iraq are mainly provided by the Ministry of Health, free of charge (nominal fee 500 IQD).

Some public facilities have semi-private facilities where patients contribute to the cost of treatment.

Refugees and IDPs have free access to health services including, consultations, medicines, laboratory tests, screenings, surgeries, emergency care, vaccination, care for mothers and infants, & dental care... etc.

Emergency services are available at public health facilities. There are three emergency hospitals in Sulaymaniyah.

In addition, Emergency wards are available at other hospitals.

 Mental health services are available at Sulaymaniyah psychiatric hospital, free of charge Ante-Natal-Care (ANC),
Post-Natal-Care (PNC)
are available at Primary Health
Care centers, free of charge.



Vaccines are available at Primary Health Care centers, free of charge. If you have a child less than five years old, you have to visit the nearest PHCC to your home.



When there is a waiting list for surgeries or tests, you need to register your name.



 Advanced screenings like MRI, CT-Scan are available at hospitals, free of charge. In addition, X-RAY is available 24 hr., free of charge.



Laboratory tests are available, free of charge, at Primary Health Care centers, hospitals & central laboratory. Basic lab tests are available at primary health care centers while more advanced tests are available at hospitals and Sulaymaniyah central laboratory.





Delivery (normal vaginal delivery and cesarean section) is available atmaternity hospital with the nominal fee.



If you have a chronic disease (Hypertension, Diabetes, Ischemic heart disease, Asthma, etc.), you should visit a hospital to confirm the diagnosis of your illness.

Then after, the hospital will refer you to a specialized PHCC to give you a card to receive your medications on a monthly basis.



The hospitals are open 24 hours while Primary Health Care centers are open from 8:00 am to 2:00 pm. In addition, some primary health care centers are open in the afternoon from 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm

(Health insurance), and ticket price for these particular PHCCs is 2,000 - 3,000IQD, where more types of medicines, more types of lab tests are available.
