Call for Applications - 2026-27 Cohort (Jordan)

Welcome Corps on Campus is a program for refugee students. Through this program refugee students receive academic and community support as they begin their studies in the United States. Campus sponsor groups welcome refugee students processed through the U.S. Refugee Admissions Program and approved for resettlement. Sponsors provide services necessary for cultural, social, and academic adjustment.

The application period for refugee students currently in Jordan will close **on October 13, 2024 at 11:59 PM (Amman local time)**. Applications will not be accepted after this time.

Eligibility Criteria (Jordan)

Applicants must:

- Be currently living in Jordan
- Have registered with UNHCR, UNRWA, or the Government of Jordan as a refugee or asylum seeker on or before September 30, 2023,
 - Note: only registered individuals who do not hold Jordanian national status are eligible for the Welcome Corps on Campus program
- Be between 18-24 years old at the time of application
 - Born between January 1, 2000 and December 31, 2006
- Be single (unmarried) with no children
- Have completed secondary school and be in possession of hard copies of the original secondary school certificates at the time of application
 - Minimum grade to apply to the program is 60% (Tawjihi graduates) or equivalent
- Be competent in oral and written English and able to meet language requirements for admissions to US academic institutions
 - Note: a pre-screening Duolingo English test will be required during the shortlisting process. Applicants are recommended to conduct free Duolingo practice tests in advance (<https://englishtest.duolingo.com/applicants>)
- Be facing barriers to accessing or completing undergraduate post-secondary education
- Be self-reliant, mature and suitable for integration in the United States as an individual

Further Instructions for the Application Process (Jordan)

- Applicants must meet all eligibility requirements and possess all required documentation as outlined in the application form.
- The following documents are required and must be submitted with your application as clearly legible electronic (soft copy) attachments, saved as JPEG or PDF format.
 - UNHCR or UNRWA proof of registration or Refugee Status Determination document
 - Diploma and transcripts (if relevant)
- If your application is shortlisted, the Welcome Corps on Campus will require that applicants are in possession of the hard copy and official/original secondary education document.
- Ensure you answer all questions fully and honestly. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Changes cannot be made to a submitted application. If you make a mistake in your online application, you must submit a *new FULL* application before the application deadline. In cases where an applicant submits multiple applications, we will only consider the details in your most recent application.
