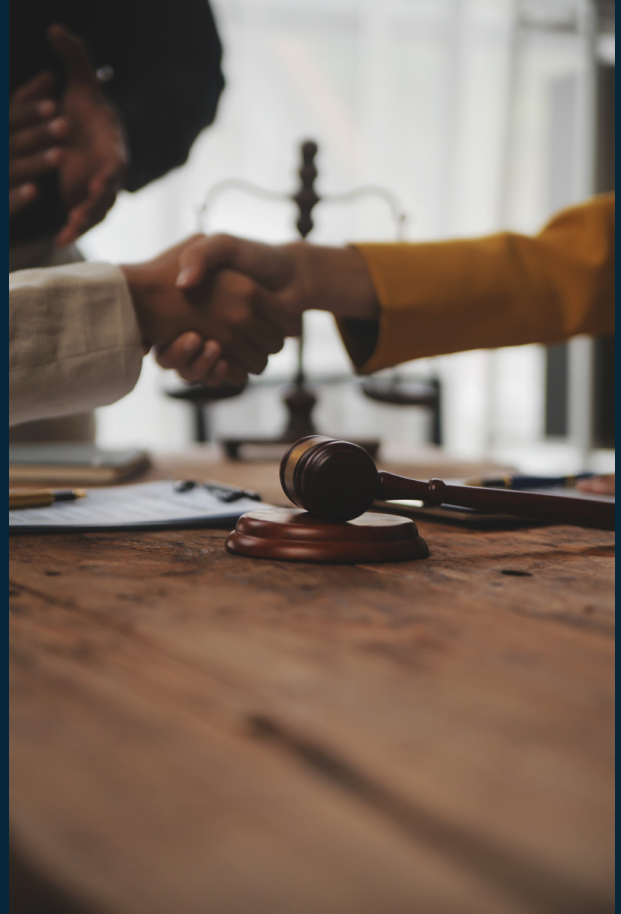
Justice should be accessible to everyone — no matter where you come from.

What Help Can You Get?

- Advice on your legal rights.
- Support with incidents in relation to legal protection, detention, expulsion or refoulement cases.
- Help with statelessness and documentation.
- Assistance with human rights complaints.

How It Works

1. Share your case with the Secretariat (contact below).
2. Your case will be reviewed confidentially.
3. If suitable, you will be matched with a lawyer who can help you for free.
