Call for Applications: Mastercard Foundation Scholars Program at the University of Global Health Equity – Master of Science in Global Health Delivery Program, Academic Year 2026/2027.

The Mastercard Foundation is partnering with the University of Global Health Equity (UGHE) to implement the Mastercard Foundation Scholars Program. This global initiative is designed to develop the next generation of transformative leaders by enabling highly talented, service-oriented young people, primarily young Africans, to pursue their higher education and cultivate their leadership potential.

The Mastercard Foundation Scholars Program is specifically designed to address the challenges faced by young individuals who lack access to higher education due to economic and social barriers. The Mastercard Foundation Scholars Program places a special emphasis on reaching young women, refugees, forcibly displaced young people, and individuals with disabilities, encouraging them to apply.

Call for Applications

UGHE invites applications for the Master of Science degree scholarship from qualified candidates from <u>African</u> <u>countries</u> who are prepared to register for full-time study in Global Health Delivery for the 2026-2027 academic year.

Program

The <u>Master of Science in Global Health Delivery</u> (MGHD) is an 18-month program designed to equip students with the skills and knowledge necessary to serve in healthcare delivery settings worldwide. By prioritizing hands-on and practical field experience, the program prepares students for real-world challenges. The Practicum, a key component of the program, provides students with hands-on experience in evidence-based management and delivery. This fosters professional development, career networking, and equips students with effective problem-solving skills. The MGHD program follows a **blended model** that combines <u>online learning</u> during the first semester (August 2026 – December 2026) with intensive <u>in-person</u> sessions during the second and third semesters (January 2027 – December 2027), allowing students to gain hands-on practice, mentorship, and networking opportunities.

Program Options:

Master of Science in Global Health Delivery (MGHD) Program under the following options:

- 1. One Health
- 2. Global Surgery
- 3. Health Management
- 4. Community and Social Medicine

Eligibility criteria:

At the time of application, an applicant must satisfy the following eligibility criteria:

- Applicants must be no older than 35 years at the time of application (exceptions apply to applicants with disabilities).
- Applicants must be residents and citizens or hold refugee status in an African country.
- Applicants should have matriculated and successfully graduated with a Bachelor's degree from any diverse academic and professional background. Official academic transcript/s and degree certificate should be attached as proof of completion.
- Applicants who are passionate about improving health outcomes, addressing inequities, and contributing to sustainable global health solutions.
- Applicants must be prepared to register for a full-time master's degree program.

A candidate who already holds a master's degree is not eligible to apply for the Mastercard Foundation Scholars Program.

How to Apply

- Fill in the <u>online application</u>, which includes an application for the Mastercard Foundation Scholars Program, entering the required demographic, academic information, and the required information for the Mastercard Foundation Scholars Program.
- Upload all supporting documents (Identification, academic transcript/s, degree certificate, recommendation letters, and proof of internship completion *if applicable).
- Applicants should submit a single, fully completed application. **Incomplete** submissions or **multiple applications** will not be considered.
- Applicants are required to **choose only one MGHD option** when applying. Submitting more than one application for different options will lead to automatic disqualification.

- 4. All selected Mastercard Foundation Scholars are expected to comply with the rules and regulations of UGHE as stipulated in the University's policies.
- 5. The Mastercard Foundation Scholars Program at UGHE will only fund Mastercard Foundation Scholars committed for full-time study at UGHE for 18 months.
- 6. All selected Mastercard Foundation Scholars take part in comprehensive support programs focused on personal, academic, and professional development. These include community-engaged learning, leadership development, and entrepreneurship training to prepare Mastercard Foundation Scholars for the workforce. Participation is mandatory.

Please note:

- The Mastercard Foundation Scholars Program at UGHE will communicate with applicants primarily via email and, when necessary, by phone. Applicants must ensure that the contact information they provide, including phone number and email address, is accurate and active to receive important updates and feedback.
